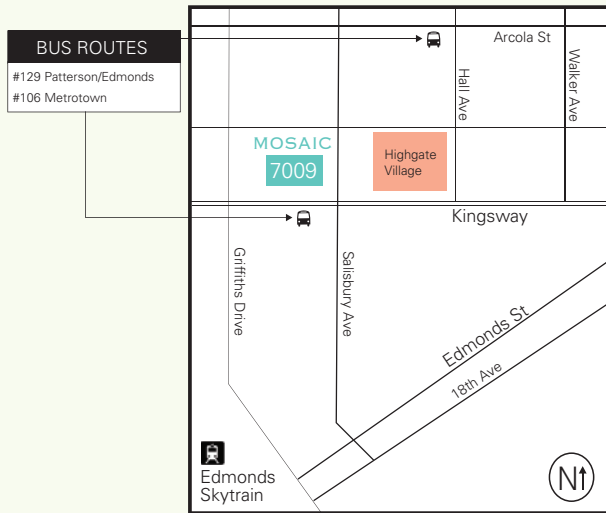

Family Centre

The MOSAIC Family Centre provides programs for families. We also provide outreach services in the community to help families navigate and locate other supports, and we are able to help our clients find meaningful volunteer opportunities.

When families first attend the Family Centre, they enter our "Welcoming Room" where they register and have their needs assessed. They are fully informed of the diverse services and programs offered through the centre and every effort is made to ensure they feel welcome, safe and comfortable.

Who is Eligible?

- Refugee parents/caregivers and children
- Families with children 0 to 6 years old
- Residing mainly in Burnaby
- Arrived in Canada within the last 5 years

Confidential Services

The Preschool and Early Learning Orientation Programs support the developmental needs of children, preparing them for mainstream programming and kindergarten.

The Newcomers Group provide information and a chance to discuss early childhood development, health issues and parenting while encouraging participants to develop their English language skills.

The Teaching Kitchen provides nutritious snacks and meals and shares information about healthy, affordable and diverse food options.

The Volunteer Program provides opportunities for parents to participate in their community and gain new skills.

One-on-One Support is provided by Family Settlement Support Workers through an individually tailored settlement plan focusing on Early Childhood Development and Parenting.

The Family Centre is part of the BC Early Years Refugee Programs initiative being carried out in six Lower Mainland communities. MOSAIC is the lead organization. We work with many community partners to make this program successful.
