What MOSAIC offers

Temporary foreign workers (TFWs) in Canada face many of the same challenges as new immigrants to Canada (struggles in understanding workplace culture, overcoming language barriers, difficulty finding the right jobs, having legal questions), but TFWs do not have the same support resources and access to services.
