What is NuYu

NuYu stands for Newcomer Youth. It is a program for immigrant and refugee youth which uses popular theatre as a tool for participants to connect with one another and reflect on their lives and experiences as newcomers. Each program session includes games, discussions and theatre activities.

Why would I be interested?

NuYu is lots of fun and a great way to connect with other immigrant and refugee youth. It's also a chance to be creative and gain tools that you can use to better express yourself. NuYu provides snacks and bus tickets at each session, as well as an honorarium for full completion of the program. You can also use your participation toward the hours of volunteer/work experience needed for high-school graduation.
