POSITION: Family Support Home Visitor at Building Blocks Program

DEPARTMENT: Family and Settlement Services

POSITION FUNCTION:

Under the direction of Manager, Children and Parenting Programs, the Family Support Home Visitor provides support to first time parents and their children, through home visiting and community-based activities. The Family Support Home Visitor works primarily with their own ethno-specific community to deliver services in the family's first language, in an effort to promote healthy child development and linkage to community resources. This position also requires a capacity to work with families from diverse multicultural backgrounds providing service in English.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be very knowledgeable about early childhood development, family/parent-child relationships and community resources and agencies, within the ethno-cultural population;
- Have a completed diploma or certificate in Social Services, Early Childhood Education, Community Development or related domain, or a combination of work experience and education resulting in equivalent credential;
- At least 2 years of early child development (with children aged 0-5yrs), family, and/or parenting related work experience and experience working with culturally diverse communities;
- Strong computer skills with the ability to use email, database, excel and other computer programs relevant to engage in electronic communication;
- Good instructional communication and problem solving skills;
- Highly organized and excellent communication skills;
- Ability to relate to and work with multiple families, program staff and other community agencies;
- Ability to motivate and be a strong role model for families and peers;
- Ability to work independently and in a team setting.

DESIRABLE SKILLS/EXPERIENCE:

- Valid driver's license and car ownership are considered assets;
- Strong English language skills, with the ability to write in English;
- Additional language skills in **Hindi, Punjabi, or Tamil** is preferred.
