Manufacturing is a cornerstone of our modern economy:

- Accounting for approximately \$174 billion of our GDP, manufacturing represents more than 10% of Canada's total GDP. What is more, manufacturers export more than \$354 billion each year, representing 68% of all of Canada's merchandise exports.
- All of this adds up to **1.7 million quality full-time, well-paying jobs—all across the country.** And as the sector has modernized, manufacturers have become innovative and high-tech, relying on a highly skilled and knowledgeable workforce that includes designers, researchers, programmers, engineers, technicians and tradespeople.



Start here:

F2M is for young newcomers (17-29 years old) who are looking for a rewarding career in the rapidly growing manufacturing field.

In partnership with **Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters**, participants will gain access to over 2,500 leading employers in the sector.

After only 6 weeks of online training, everyone will be offered full time positions with one of those employers.

Who is eligible?

- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person (under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act, S.C. 2001. C 27) legally entitled to work in Canada,
- Living in British Columbia,
- Not a full time student (i.e. not enrolled in high school or in post-secondary training),
- Not actively participating in another provincially or federally funded labour market program,
- Young adults aged 17 to 29, and
- Unemployed or underemployed.

Participants receive:

3 weeks of career workshops including:

- Job search, resume writing and interview skills
- Canadian workplace culture and communication
- Personal goal setting and decision making
- Individualized Training and Career Plan
- Training and transport allowance

3 weeks of Skills Training with Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters including:

- Health and Safety\Reading Work Orders Schematics and Drawings
- Production Reports and Quality Assurance
- WHMIS & OFA Level 1 Certificates
- Training and transport allowance
