**POSITION:** Multicultural Victim Services Worker, SAFE Project

### **POSITION FUNCTION:**

The Safeguarding and Facilitating Empowerment (SAFE) Project will develop and implement promising prevention and intervention practices to advance knowledge and enhance empowerment supports for at-risk populations and survivors of trafficking, with specific focus on immigrants, refugees, and other newcomers to Canada.

This position is responsible for providing direct services to clients who are at-risk of trafficking or have been trafficked, including: criminal justice information and support, safety planning, information and referrals, and emotional and practical support. It is important that the MVSW has an understanding of trafficking in persons and forced labour, as well as the intersectional experiences of oppression and exploitation faced by immigrants, refugees and people of colour. They must also have knowledge of community resources/services and be able to deliver educational sessions as required.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Knowledgeable about trafficking in persons, forced labour, and related issues and considerations;
- Knowledge and experience working with immigrants, refugees, and other newcomers to Canada;
- Bachelor's Degree in an area such as Human Rights, Social Work, Criminology and/or a related field, or a combination of education, training and experience;
- Experience working in victim services/anti-violence sector and advocating with and on behalf of clients;
- Working knowledge of trauma-informed practice, and an understanding of available and appropriate community resources and services;
- Experience in and comfortable with delivering educational sessions and presentations;
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team; flexibility/adaptability; high commitment to self-care;
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, able to speak, read and write in fluent English;
- Excellent organizational and time management skills and a passion for working in a diverse, multicultural environment;
- A working knowledge of standard office equipment.

**OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

- A current and satisfactory Criminal Record Check

**HOURS:** 28 hrs per week

Please note, this is a limited term position until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023.

This position will be based at our Vancouver location and may require occasional travel to other service locations. Due to COVID, services are presently being delivered remotely, and are subject to change based on current public health directives.

**STARTING PAY:** \$23.93 - \$27.52 per hour, commensurate with qualifications and experience
